PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK EVENT

On Saturday, April 29, 2017, the Town & Country Police Department, in partnership with the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA), will host a Prescription Drug Take Back Event to collect expired and unwanted prescription medication. According to DEA statistics, approximately 60% of heroin users started abusing prescription pain killers from a parent's or relative's medicine cabinet before trying heroin. Additionally, improper disposal of these medications can lead to the contamination of public water sources. This collection event, and others like it, help to avoid the improper use or abuse of these medications and keeps them out of our watershed, allowing for a safe and proper disposal method.

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT THIS EVENT:

- ⊗ Illegal drugs (Marijuana, Cocaine, etc.)
- ⊗ Sharps (Such as syringes, insulin pens, etc.)
- ⊗ Radioactive medicines
- ⊗ Bio-hazardous materials
- ⊗ Glass thermometers or other medical devices
- ⊗ Bulk medication from businesses such as pharmacies, doctor's offices, or hospitals
- ⊗ **Only medication from individuals will be accepted**
