### **Old Business**

- A. A motion was introduced by Mr. Conrad to approve the January 15, 2019 minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Jaudes and unanimously approved.

### **New Business**

A. Chair Report

- A retirement reception for Chief Hoelzer is scheduled for Friday March 29, 2019. The reception will be held at Longview Farm Park.
- The Chairman introduced Pam Holman, the aldermanic candidate for Ward 1 and Melissa Gordan (wife of Police Commissioner Dave Gordan).
- The Chairman introduced Mr Kyriakos as the new Police Commissioner for Ward 3.
- The Chairman advised the Commission the Taser proposal was approved by the Board of Aldermen.

B. Chief's Report

- The Chief will provide a copy of the Standard Operating Procedure for Tasers at the next Commission meeting.
- The Chief will presented the newly promoted Officers to the Commission at the next meeting. If the new Officers have been hired, they will also be introduced to the Commission.

C. Fire Chief's Report

- The Chief presented an overview of the ISO inspection. The overall rating for the district was 85.51 out of a possible 105.6. The 2 areas that can be addressed are; water flow testing (the district has now assumed responsibility for that task) and relational geography of fire stations. The locations for fire stations will require further review and discussion.
- The Chief reviewed 2019 activity to date with the Commission. The review entails calls by; location type, call type, and response times by ward.

D. The Commission discussed the Better Together Initiative and the possible outcomes. There will be a loss of services and encumbered costs without specific revenue sources. The Board of Aldermen on March 11, 2019 passed a resolution in favor of the Board of Freeholders and in opposition of the Better Together Initiative.

The next Commission meeting is scheduled for May 14, 2019.
