1. Call to Order

Alderman Wittmaier called the meeting to order at 12:07 PM and the roll, as noted above, was called. There was a quorum.

2. Approval of March 1, 2021 Minutes

3. Discussion – Green Thumb Awards

Morgan presented an updated version of the informational flyer.
