1. Call to Order

Ms. Kuepfert called the meeting to order at 12:06 p.m. and the roll as noted above was taken. There was a quorum.

2. Approval of March 12, 2020 Minutes

Ms. Robson moved for approval, seconded by Ms. Blake and unanimously approved.

3. Terra-cycling – Status and Next Steps
