RESOLUTION NO. R15-2019**

**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO WITHDRAW THE PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED  
APPLICATION FOR A SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT FOR PHASE 2 OF  
THE TOPPING ROAD RESURFACING AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, in January of 2019, the Board of Aldermen approved Resolution No. R04-2019 authorizing the submittal of an application for a Surface Transportation Block Grant for Phase 2 of the Topping Road Resurfacing and Pedestrian Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pedestrian Improvements detailed in the application included an eight, (8) foot wide multi use path; and


**WHEREAS**, resident feedback during public open house meetings has been in support of reducing the width from eight (8) foot to five (5) foot path in order to protect vegetation, lessen impact on neighboring residential properties and reduce stormwater runoff, and

**WHEREAS**, the reduction in the width of the path impacts the scoring criteria and the current application would not qualify for funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TOWN & COUNTRY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Staff is hereby directed to withdraw the application that was submitted to the East-West Gateway Council of Governments for the Topping Road Resurfacing and Pedestrian Improvements Project, Phase 2.
