**COURT ORDER**

**VIOLATIONS BUREAU SCHEDULE OF OFFENSES AND FINES**

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 37.495 the undersigned Municipal Judge of the City of Town and Country hereby orders that the following designated offenses may be payable to the City of Town and Country Violations Bureau. A person may pay the specified amount of the fine and costs to the Bureau in person, by mail, or through an electronic payment system before the court date and time for the initial court appearance. Said payment constitutes a guilty plea and waiver of trial.

**When payment through the Violations Bureau is not permitted-exceptions**

Anyone 17 years of age or younger must appear in court on all moving violations with a parent or legal guardian. Any ticket involving an accident requires a court appearance.

**Court Costs**

In accordance with Missouri statutes and ordinances adopted by the City, total Court Costs shall be \$33.50. This includes Basic Court Costs of \$12.00, Crime Victim's Compensation Surcharge of \$7.50, Law Enforcement Training Fund of \$1.00, Peace Officer's Standard Training Fund of \$2.00, Biometric Verification System Surcharge of \$2.00; Domestic Violence Shelter of \$2.00 and an Automation fee of \$7.00 for a total of \$33.50. Court costs shall be paid in addition to the fine.

Payment by way of the Violations Bureau shall constitute a guilty plea and the waiver of a trial.

(Charges amended by recommendation of the Prosecuting Attorney are not reflected on this Order. However, the Court is authorized to take payment on said recommendation in the Violations Bureau with full payment and a signed copy of the recommendation. Final disposition is subject to court approval.)

This schedule of fines and costs are subject to change due to any change in state or local laws.

Sharon Orlando and Yvonne Monroe are hereby appointed as the Violations Bureau Clerks. It shall be their duty to accept appearances, waiver of trials, pleas of guilty, and payment of fine and costs for the designated violations, enter the pleas on the record, and transmit the violation records as required by law.
